Hospice services are offered wherever the patient resides, and may be offered in the patient's private home, nursing home, community-based residential facility (CBRF), residential care apartment complex (RCAC), hospital or Unity's Jack and Engrid Meng Residence. Palliative Care is a specialty that focuses on the relief of suffering and the improvement in quality of life across the spectrum of a serious illness. These services are provided by an interdisciplinary team that supports the physical, spiritual and emotional needs of the patient and family.

VETERANS STATE CEMETERIES

Veterans, their spouses and dependent children may be buried at state veterans cemeteries operated by Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA). WDVA currently operates three State Veterans Cemeteries. State veterans cemeteries are located near Union Grove (Racine County), near Spooner (Washburn County), and at the Wisconsin Veterans Home at King (Waupaca County). The eligibility for burial is based on the past military service established as a veteran, national guard member or reservist with honorable active-duty service, military disability ratings or those who have at least 20 years of service towards retirement. Burial of an eligible veteran is at no cost to the veteran. A fee is charged at the time of interment for spouses and dependent children of eligible veterans. Veterans are encouraged to establish eligibility and pre-register for interment by contacting one of the cemeteries. VETERANS DEPENDENTS AND SURVIVORS BENEFITS – FEDERAL

Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC), Death Pension, Home Loan Guaranties, Dependents' Education. Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC) is payable to certain survivors of: Servicemembers who died on active duty, Veterans who died from service-related disabilities, Certain veterans who were being paid 100% VA disability compensation at time of death. VETERANS DISABILITY COMPENSATION – FEDERAL

Disability compensation is a monetary benefit paid to veterans who are disabled by injury or disease incurred or aggravated during active military service. The service of the veteran must have been terminated through separation or discharge under conditions other than dishonorable. Disability compensation varies with the degree of disability and the number of dependents, and is paid monthly. The benefits are not subject to federal or state income tax. The payment of military retirement pay, disability severance pay and separation incentive payments known as SSB and VSI also affects the amount of VA compensation paid. <http://www.vba.va.gov/bln/21/index.htm>

Montgomery GI Bill, Veterans Educational Assistance Program (VEAP) Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance. Time Limits: Generally, *veterans* have 10 years from the date they were last released from active duty to use their education benefits. *Reservists* generally have 10 years from the date they became eligible for the program unless they leave the Selected Reserves before completing their obligation. *Spouses* generally have 10 years from the date the VA first finds them eligible. *Children* are generally eligible from age 18 until age 26. These time limits can sometimes be extended.

VETERANS ELIGIBILITY – WISCONSIN BENEFITS

To qualify for most Wisconsin state veterans' benefits, programs, or services, a veteran must first establish general eligibility for Wisconsin state veterans' benefits. Eligibility criteria for Wisconsin state veterans' benefits, programs, and services, including exceptions to minimum military service requirements, are set in state law (Wis.Stats.Ch.45). General eligibility consists of two broad requirements: Military service (Character; Type; Duration), *and* State residency.

The Federal Department of Veterans Affairs provides a number of health care services. Hospital, outpatient medical, dental, pharmacy and prosthetic services, Domiciliary, nursing home, and community-based residential care. Sexual trauma counseling, Specialized health care for women veterans, Health and rehabilitation programs for homeless veterans, Readjustment counseling, Alcohol and drug dependency treatment, Medical evaluation for military service exposure, including Gulf War, Agent Orange, radiation, or other environmental hazards.

VETERANS PENSION – FEDERAL

Veterans with low incomes who are permanently and totally disabled, or are age 65 and older, may be eligible for monetary support if they have 90 days or more of active military service, at least one day of which was during a period of war. The discharge from active duty must have been under conditions other than dishonorable. The permanent and total disability must be for reasons other than the veteran's own willful misconduct. Payments are made to qualified veterans to bring their total income, including other retirement or Social Security income, to a level set by Congress. Unreimbursed medical expenses may reduce countable income. Veterans of a period of war who are age 65 or older and meet service and income requirements are also eligible to receive a pension, regardless of current physical condition.

WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM

The Weatherization Program is funded through the State of Wisconsin with funds from the U.S. Department of Energy, Public Benefits, and WHEAP to address major sources of heat loss in low-income houses. People who are deemed high-energy users by the State of Wisconsin, according to the amount of energy assistance the family receives, are first priority for weatherization. Once eligibility has been established, the client is contacted by an energy auditor, who determines what work needs to be done to the home. After the audit, a crew will go to the home and actually perform the work prescribed by the audit under the careful supervision of a field coordinator. Such work may include insulating, working on attics and sidewalls, and replacing furnaces, water heaters, etc. Must have an annual income at or below 60% of the State Median Income Guidelines and have applied for WHEAP.
