## **Chapter Project**

Assignment Prompt

150 points

### *Description*

Here is your chance to become an expert on one aspect of Television studies. You will be assigned one chapter from the textbook and you will be responsible for constructing the materials we use to work through the chapter. The materials you will need to develop and/or provide include:

- Chicago Style bibliographic citation of the chapter (5 points)
- Chapter Outlines/Notes (15 points)
  - Do not quote from the textbook unless it is critical that you use the terminology provided.
- Key Terms from the Chapter (the terms and their definitions) (15 points)
  - Do not just rely on what terms are in bold or italics!
- Associate with Relevant Course Outcomes (with brief descriptions of how/why the chapter is relevant) (15 points)
- 4-8 Chapter Reading Quiz Questions (and answers; multiple choice, t/f, matching, fill in the blank, short essay answer, etc.) (10 points)
- Suggestions of 3-4 Shows/Episodes to View (at least one must be either available on the internet and/or easily available in video rental stores and at least one must not come from the book) (15 points)
- 4-6 Discussion Questions (two of which must make participants watch one of the listed shows/episodes; one of which must be the easily available show/episode; one of which must engage with a related course outcome) (15 points)
  - Questions must be open ended enough to allow discussion; therefore, nothing that is yes/no or only one correct answer.

### *Deadlines*

- 9/6/08--submit full draft to instructor as an email attachment (10 points for complete draft)
- 9/6/08--provide instructor with a list of at least 5 times/dates between 9/6-13 that you can meet to discuss your draft. You can choose to meet during the later half of class period on 9/8. Meetings can be face-to-face or by phone. You will want to schedule 30 minutes for the meetings. (10 points)
- 9/13/08--Complete Final of Chapter Project, email to the instructor (90 points--see breakdown above)
- 9/13/08--Post revised Chapter Project material to the wiki (notes, key terms w/o definitions, associations to course outcomes, and example shows to view)
- Week your Chapter is Covered in Class--Facilitate Online Discussion, keep pushing your classmates to think about different aspects of the topics/ideas/concepts covered in your chapter. (40 points)
